# RISE Application

## Who can apply?

All students who will be entering their 8<sup>th</sup> grade year in fall of 2020.

## What is RISE?

RISE is a leadership team for 8<sup>th</sup> grade students who will serve during Rainbow Express. Rainbow Express is a day camp for children and teens with special needs. The Junior High Ministry partners with the special needs ministry to serve with the children's program during this week. Our goal in partnering is to foster relationships between the students in our ministries, to help our students see value in people who are often marginalized in the world, and to develop our students as leaders. Our students serve in the following ways: 1 on 1 counselors, stations assistants, and support staff. Our students also help prepare decorations and materials for the camp by attending at least one prep night the week before camp. We train and equip our students to work with children with special needs; no previous experience is required.

The Rainbow Express camp our students will be serving is located at church and runs from 9:00am-1:30pm. Outside of camp, we spend a considerable amount of time teaching and training on servant leadership. As we build upon the hands-on experience during the week, we spend time discussing and learning specifically from the Gospels' pictures of Jesus as the servant leader, with the hope that the students would take what they learn in this time into their spheres of influence and model Christ to their communities.

This week is a great time for junior high students to grow and learn more about what it means to serve others and grow in their relationship with Christ. We believe this time can be very beneficial and is fun, **but we do want to stress that this is a serious trip for students who desire to serve and grow. This will be a stretching experience.**



## Trip Information

**Cost:** \$135 (this includes: all meals, activities, transportation)

### General Information:

Students are with us from July 25th- July 31st. They will stay with us at church on Saturday July 25th for training and preparation for the week, and will spend the entire week with us from Saturday to Friday evening. We sleepover at church, work at camp during the day and have various activities and trainings planned each evening. We treat this week like an out-of-town service trip, and plan for students to be with us the entire time. Because we will be on and off campus at various times, and for the unity of the team, we cannot accommodate students coming and going. Please keep this in mind as you and your student prayerfully consider applying for this team.

**Location:** Fullerton Free Campus.

### Application Process:

All incoming 8<sup>th</sup> grade students must apply to serve at Rainbow Express. We will evaluate all applications and have a decision on the final team by May 17th. Once the team is selected, we will schedule 30 min. slots with each student for a goal setting meeting. **Spaces are limited so students are encouraged to turn in applications as quickly as possible.**
