

Easter Week Family Activities

- Read a few pages of the Easter story booklet each day to prepare your hearts for Easter Sunday.
- Palm Sunday Parade
 - Gather items that make noise from around the house and coats.
 - Take turns letting each family member play the role of Jesus coming into town, as the other family members throw down their coats and yell "Hosanna".
- Resurrection Egg Coloring Sheet
 - Pick a few eggs from the coloring sheet and look up the verse on that egg.
 - Take time to talk about what is happening in those verses.
 - When you are done color in the eggs you have discussed and hand them somewhere in your house.
- As a family, take time to complete the "Dear God" prompt sheet.
- Good Friday
 - Take turns washing each other's feet just as you talk about what Jesus did in John 13:1-17.
 - Gather twigs from outside and make small crosses as you discuss how Jesus died on the cross for our sins. On Easter Sunday create a sign for that cross that says He is Risen!
- Easter Sunday
 - Create a He Is Risen banner and hang it in your window for your neighborhood to see.
 - Use construction paper to create a stained glass cross in your window.
 - As a family complete the 5 things I love about Easter worksheet.
