

RISE Application

Who can apply?

All students who will be entering their 8th grade year in fall of 2024.

What is RISE?

RISE is a leadership team for **8**th **grade students** who will serve during Vacation Bible School. VBS is a 4-day day program for children in grades 1-5 to learn about the gospel in a fun setting. The Middle School Ministry partners with the Kids ministry to serve with the children's program during this week.

Our goal in partnering is to show students what true selfless service looks like at a first hand level. Our students serve in the following ways: grade counselors, station assistants, and support staff. Our students also help prepare decorations and materials for the camp by attending at least one prep afternoon the week before camp (July 2nd). We train and equip our students to work with children; no previous experience is required.

Our students will be serving at our church VBS, which runs from **July 8-11th, from 8:30am-12:30pm**. Outside of VBS, we spend a considerable amount of time teaching and training on servant leadership. As we build upon the hands-on experience during the week, we spend time discussing and learning specifically from the Gospels' pictures of Jesus as the servant leader, with the hope that the students would take what they learn in this time into their spheres of influence and model Christ to their communities.

This week is a great time for eighth grade students to grow and learn more about what it means to serve others and grow in their relationship with Christ. We believe this time can be very beneficial and is fun, but we do want to stress that this is a serious trip for students who desire to serve and grow. This will be a stretching experience.



Trip Information

Cost: \$100 (this includes: all meals, activities, transportation)

General Information:

Students are with us from July 8th-11th. They will stay with us at church Monday, July 8th to Wednesday, July 10th. This will be in order to do team building activities and class bonding. We sleepover at church, work at VBS during the day and have various activities (like anAngels game) and training planned for each evening. We treat this week like an out-of-town service trip, and plan for students to be with us the entire time.

Location: Fullerton Free Campus.

Application Process:

All incoming 8th grade students must apply to serve at VBS (online on a separate form). We will evaluate all applications and get back to you as soon as we can.

All applicants are responsible to give the Leader reference to one of their volunteer leaders (NOT KELLEN or NOHEMI)
